Friday Night Cruise-In

Join our first-ever Friday Night Cruise-In. The showfield registration office opens at 3 p.m. Showfield registrants may simply park to be eligible for "Carlisle Pick" awards or also register for the limbo competition. At around 8 p.m. (or just after the limbo ends) we will present the cruise-in awards.

Friday Night Car & Truck Limbo

Any vehicle that is registered for the showfield may enter the limbo contest. You must register for the contest on Friday at Guest Services between 4 and 6:45 p.m. Cars will take a pass under the bar, paradestyle, and continue until a winner is crowned. This year's limbo contest will be in traditional limbo style. Instead of measuring from the driver door or roof, each competitor will attempt to drive their vehicle under the limbo bar without knocking it off and without smoking their tires. The last vehicle to make it under the bar without knocking it down wins. Driver's license and proof of insurance are required.

Your shopping options include the midway and vending area, where you'll find new parts, apparel, collectibles, literature, stickers and more as well as the first-ever swap meet where you can shop for used parts and accessories.

The machine can measure what type of horsepower and torque your vehicle has, and shows it in real time on their large video screen. A fee applies for each run, \$75 for three pulls if paying by cash; \$80 if using a credit card.

There are many changes taking place at Carlisle Performance & Style this year. You may have already noticed that the showfield looks a little different than you are accustomed to and if you didn't know, camping has returned too. One portion of this weekend that should look familiar is the LowLifeStyles/JunkStyles displays in the Pavilion and Building T.

Have you ever wondered about the story behind their name? In an e-mail exchange recently with Brand Manager Shawn Baker, he tried his best to explain the company's background.

"The original two founders, Nick Becker and Eric Hess, came up with the JunkStyles name. They were just selling a handful of different humorous sticker designs that they'd come up with. They soon asked me to jump on board to help with creative design and marketing aspects. Together, we formed the LowLifeStyle.com website as a place to sell our stickers, T-shirts and other accessories." Baker continued, "The website also serves as a blog for all things connected to the 'Low Life' and includes anything youth- and autoculture-related."

The P&S crowd certainly is keen on that and so much more. If you are fresh to the hobby and want to know what "Low Life" means, it can be best described as cars, fashion, lifestyle, sports, etc. Ultimately, it's where like-minded people go so they can be connected to their interests in a single area.

LowLifeStyles/JunkStyles will be part of the event for the third year and can be found in Building T. Though it may be the third go-around for the group, as individuals they've been coming for as long as P&S has existed. Coming to Carlisle isn't their only gig, either; the group can be found at other lifestyle events and European-inspired car shows like H2Ointernational and Mk1 Madness. In addition, they can be found at a lot of meets where they are able to take a more laidback approach to pitching their cause. As you can see, there are many options for them, so why Carlisle?

"This event is right in our back yard and it's our hometown event," Baker said. "All of our friends attend the event, and this event is one where it isn't so much about the money that we can make, rather a way for us to help the show grow larger each year and stay true to this car movement. That's why we arrange a cool display of our own each year at the show. We help to show people the latest trends in aggressive stance and wheel/tire fitment."

With just two days to meander the grounds, you'll want to plan accordingly, and that means knowing what you should expect when you visit their display. Plan to check out some of the most aggressively fitted cars at the event, plus know that you can shop for fresh gear, stickers and other cool accessories. They will also host all sorts of entertainment and provide a unique atmosphere.

Alexi DeRochambeau's Dream Come True

Throughout our history here at Carlisle, we've seen some special people come and go. Generally, their automotive excitement brings them to us and sometimes something much worse takes them away. Our co-founder, Chip Miller, was one such person. His passion for collector cars, specifically the Corvette, launched one of the most popular events of its type in the world. Sadly, a rare disease took him from us in 2004. Another such enthusiast, Eli Ault, was a focal point of a special display at the Carlisle Chrysler Nationals in July of 2011. For Eli, the Chrysler weekend was one of the last major events of his life. Eli passed away due to complications from cancer in October of 2011. Though other friends of Carlisle have passed in recent years, there is one family here this weekend that is helping carry on the tradition of their car-crazy son, Alexi DeRochambeau, who passed away peacefully in his sleep in 2011.

Alexi loved cars, so much so that he had high hopes and big dreams for his blue VW Golf. Work associated with the car was dubbed Project Blue by one of Alexi's friends after he passed. The purpose was to encourage people to help work on the car each Sunday during in the months following his passing and to see through the visions he had for his 1998 Mk3 CL. Alexi was an easy-going, resourceful young man, too. His mother Nancy noted, "He was fun to be around and very caring. He was creative, giving and really did all that he could to make the best of any situation. He was passionate about everything that he was part of, especially cars, bikes friends and family."

It was his passion, drive and determination that helped create the car you see today in Building T. While some may already know the story of Alexi and his car, many more do not. This car is uniquely special, with aspects only a mind like Alexi's could create. Take for example the rear door windows. These windows were specific to a three-door car and Alexi managed to find a clever way to make them fit neatly into his four-door ride. This was in 2008 and in the years since, Alexi put many more touches into the machine.

There were times during the project that Alexi had to beg, borrow and trade parts just to see that the proper pieces and parts made it onto the car. In life

and then after, a great array of enthusiasts and friends helped with the car. The list is long, with too many names, companies, etc., to mention at this point. The degree of which people wanted to help was never more evident then when Alexi passed and people began posting on his build thread online and via his Facebook page that they wanted to help see Project Blue through. When Alexi passed away, he was into what was considered phase two of Project Blue. It did not take long for the people closest to him to band together and finish the car.

"My husband and I knew Alexi had a large group of friends who both then and now continue to support all that we do. One-hundred percent of money raised via Project Blue goes to another Rhode Island group, the Krob Foundation, that provides bikes to children in need," Nancy said.

Elements of this ride include a shaved engine bay, right-hand drive conversion, firewall conversion, unique wheel design and development, special wheels, smoothed and straightened sills, European-spec highline bumpers all around, duckbill spoiler, black suede headlining and parcel shelf with all factory black Euro pillars, Euro center console and switch, threespoke leather steering wheel and so much more!

Since his passing, Foundation Blue was established to honor the memory of Alexi and get his Project Blue VW to shows such as Carlisle Performance & Style. In addition, Foundation Blue helps with upkeep of the car. Money comes to the Foundation via donations, and because Alexi's vision, sketched on a paper napkin, is the basis for the wheels that adorn his car, whenever a set like them are sold by wheel manufacturer fifteen52, a large piece of the sale goes to the Foundation, too.

As for what it's like to see the car out and about, Nancy says, "It's always emotional for everyone involved. Sometimes I think we're looking over our shoulder for Alexi, who is the one person missing from a show where the car is on display. The car has won many "Best of Show" honors and has been recognized nationally and internationally in magazines. I couldn't be happier with the end result and this would not have been possible without the help of so many great people. Alexi would be so proud."

2013 Scion FR-S John Toca, Chicago, IL

Getting into the car scene in his late teens, John began working on his 2006 Scion tC, which at the time was his daily driver. He started off like many, getting involved in local car clubs, but eventually outgrew it and moved on to bigger and more bold projects. John started up and created Toca Series in 2010 while showing with high-end car clubs that toured the United States. Being able to see how others expressed themselves through their vehicles has always been something he has admired. His inspiration for this 2013 Scion FR-S comes from a variety of places. Some of the inspiration comes from city life in Chicago, some from friends and some from other sport cars. He believes the most important aspect of building a car is the attention to detail and the way things are executed. Parts should never look out of place and in general should always be functional. He believes with every part and modification done to the vehicle, keeping the mindset of a "factory looking" car should always be in the back of your head; meaning every modification done should look as though it could have come from the factory like that. John's theme for this 2013 Scion FR-S was to have a car that was both "show and go." What would a car in the city be without audio? With that in mind he did not want to take away from what the car stood for, especially on the performance side, so he designed the custom sub tube to be removable. The car's suspension system has been completely redone using high-end Cusco parts and heavily braced for track use. John says the car is great for cruising down the street or letting loose on a course. Function is something that he takes seriously and always strives for; therefore, everything on the car that you may think is just for looks actually has a purpose. The side fender vents, which were originally closed, were opened up and widened, allowing heat to exit from the engine bay. The same goes for the hood scoop, allowing more air to flow in. Staying true to the brand, the hood scoop comes from a Toyota 4Runner he cut out and welded into the stock FR-S hood. The power pushing this build comes from a Vortech supercharger that opens up the cars inner beast, while gripping the ground with Pirelli P Zero tires. John believes this build truly shows the FR-S's potential and what it has to offer on a variety of levels. John Toca's FR-S, another impressive Tuner Challenge car, will join his old East Coast teammates as a featured vehicle of the Scion Trilogy Tour at Carlisle's Performance & Style event.



2012 Scion FR-S Chris Basselgia, Harrisburg, PA

A car build is, in fact, a rolling work of art. The car is the canvas on which the designer gets to bring his vision to life. Chris Basselgia's vision is one of functionality and class. Being a brand-new vehicle to the Scion line-up of cars, the FR-S presented Chris with the unique opportunity to paint a picture unlike anyone has seen before. Major and subtle changes were implemented not to create a new vehicle, but to enhance the beauty and performance that was already created by Scion. Unique color combinations that not only flow together but create a pleasant and fresh emotion on top of the clean lines that are not only aggressive but also sexy and elegant were the focus of the exterior. The same mindset follows into the interior, where the driver and passengers will enjoy luxury while being thrilled by the powerplant under the hood. In this build, Chris faced the challenge of being creative in his design while maintaining functionality and being sure to cover all of the bases necessary for a show-stopping vehicle. In the end, Chris has shown that all of this can be achieved with style and class and without the unnecessary bolt-on clutter often seen in builds of this nature. This car is fresh on the scene, but photo shoots for major international magazines have already been scheduled. It will also be featured in two-page spread, Scion Racing advertisements nationally. Since this is the newest edition to the WR Team trio of Tuner Challenge winners, this vehicle will be the flagship of the 2013 Scion Trilogy Tour, which kicks off right here at Carlisle Performance & Style.



2011 Scion tC Shawn Baker, Harrisburg, PA

The inspiration behind this tC is that form follows function. Shawn Baker believes that it's really more about quality and craftsmanship than quantity of modifications when it comes to customizing a vehicle. Since Scion completely redesigned the vehicle that year, he wanted to stay true to its new look, only making moves that complimented the car. The focus of the project was on attention to detail and functional performance-based styling. So all modifications whether major or subtle - needed to be top quality and performed with factory precision. Being a huge fan of the clean look, Shawn wanted to emphasize the things that he enjoys most out of building a custom car: unique colors/finishes, raw performance, and of course a super-aggressive stance. Instead of bolting on a bunch of extra non-functional items, Baker chose to use creativity through design elements such as fitment, finish and texture to draw attention to the high quality, functional custom aspects of the car. While the car may seem subtle at first, it actually covers all of the bases that a show-winning vehicle should cover on its own terms. While the Scion Tuner Challenge build-off is a competition, Shawn's true goal was to build a car that automotive enthusiasts, current Scion owners and potential customers would want to drive and enjoy on a daily basis. A build like this challenges the creative mind... and invites show car builders to tone down the clutter while at the same time stepping up their game. Shawn went on to win first place in Scion's Best-of-the-Best Tuner Challenge. The car was also featured in Import Tuner Magazine, made the cover of S3 Magazine, and was used in major promotional advertising for Scion Racing. The car has toured with Scion to most of the major national and international Auto Shows, but is about to embark on the Scion Trilogy Tour — which will feature three East Coast Tuner Challenge winners built within the same crew.



2009 Scion xB Pete Colello, Harrisburg, PA

Peter Colello's plan for the Scion Tuner Challenge xB build was not to change what he does best, which is to produce well-rounded show cars with pure functionality, but to build and expand from his past projects. He also used the key components from his past projects, such as over-the-top attention to detail and one-off components. One goal for this project was not to cater to one type of demographic but to reach out to the masses, whether it is the car audio nuts, the gearheads or the strictly styling guys. This is a car that can be admired, appreciated and understood by all. Colello's xB was victorious in the Tuner Challenge at SEMA 2009, bringing home 1st place honors as the first East Coast builder to win the competition. The vehicle was later on the cover of Performance Auto & Sound (January 2010) and was also toured for years with Scion Corporate. Be on the lookout for more of this car this summer on the Scion Trilogy Tour.
