



/ any cars will go through a type of cycle in their life where, initially, they represent the best a company has to offer and are at the forefront of performance. Eventually, after the cars are about 10 years old or so, they start to become cheaper and more affordable to used car buyers. They then will start to get lower to the bottom of their price range, which means they can be bought cheaply by younger enthusiasts. For a while, the Third Generation Camaro was in the bottom portion of its value curve, and many cars were purchased by people who wanted inexpensive, V8. rear wheel drive cars to have fun in and beat on

Now, however, the Third Generation Camaro, especially the IROC-Z, has started to gradually climb in value. People are beginning to recognize the simple mechanics, reliable power and unique retro styling of these cars. Given, there are still some pretty rough examples around, but that can be true for just about any car produced. The IROC-Zs are starting to bring very decent money, with low-mileage and uniquely-optioned examples sometimes bringing \$20,000 or more when sold to the right buyer. The IROC-Z is becoming a future classic, meaning it is gaining popularity as a collectible and respected car.

The stereotypes surrounding Third Gen owners are still prevalent (we even have a club called the Mullet Militia!), but now it is mentioned more in jest rather than in all seriousness. You can still drive through a rural area and likely see a roughed-up Third Gen parked under a tree, covered in sap, sitting on cinder blocks and long since forgotten. But, you can also go to a car show and see a beautifully preserved or restored Third Gen, with a passionate and enthusiastic owner at the wheel. The IROC-Z and the Third Gen family have started an upward trend in the hobby. These uniquely-styled, retro cars have a lot to offer with a plentiful aftermarket and a very dedicated fan base. The next time you see a Third Gen Camaro and question its place in the collector car hobby, just remember that at one point in time, your classic car may have been viewed as "too new" or "not a true collector car" by another group. These cars are just taking their journey through the cycle of collectability and I, for one, am glad to see these spectacular vehicles moving into the spotlight.

A representative example of payment terms are as follows: Based on a simple interest rate of 4.99% for a \$20,000 loan, this loan would have 48 monthy payments of \$460.50 each at an APR of 5.89%.


