"Camaro #1 should grab a ton of attention. Who doesn't want to see the first Camaro ever!? Just seeing all generations together is going to be awesome," says Ben.



THE FIVE MILLIONTH CHEVROLET CAMARO 2011 Chevrolet Camaro Lance Miller

Camaro N100001 was the first of 49 pilot cars built by Chevrolet at the Norwood Assembly Plant. This car, along with the 48 other pilots, was built to ensure compatibility with mass production when it came to tooling and machinery used in the process. These pilot cars were crucial to refining the setup of the factory and helped to get everything ready for mass production of the first Generation Camaro. In the end, the pilot cars differed from prototypes because they were real, functioning automobiles upon completion. Camaro #001 was used by Chevrolet as a display vehicle at trade and auto shows and came equipped with a special 110-volt static lighting display, as well as Grenada Gold paint, a standard 230 straight-six engine, whitewall tires and a push-button radio. The Camaro was eventually retired from the show circuit, had its lighting display removed, and made its way to Ayers High Performance Chevrolet in Yukon, OK to live life as a showroom attraction. Ayers Chevrolet eventually sold the car, which then passed through several owners and even became a drag car at one point in its life. Eventually, the historical importance of the car was recognized and it was sold to the current owner, who had it painstakingly restored to its original condition. Camaro N100001 represents a significant piece of General Motors history, and was literally the first of its kind to ever exist.








SPOTLIGHT: MIKE HEIM'S 1967 V12 CHEVROLET CAMARO

The experience of seeing Mike Heim's '67 V12 Camaro in the flesh is pure hallucination; if Hunter S. Thompson were still alive and could rewrite Fear & Loathing in Las Vegas, he'd be kicking himself for not speeding across the desert in this hellion instead of the Eldorado.


Mike manages a team of six at Quality Custom Rides in Lancaster, PA, all who have helped the transformation of the V12 Camaro. Its one-of-a-kind slammed exoskeleton is attributed to several mutations, including a 3" body drop, an Air Ride suspension (dropping the car another 5"), removal of rockers (another 4.5" lower), a top chop of 1.25", firewall smoothing and forward movement of the radiator to clear the block for the grand centerpiece of the build: a bespoke LS-based V12 engine. Coated in slime green paint that amplifies its hyperbolic power, the V12 LS is 8.8" longer than the standard V8. 12 individual throttle bodies and new, improved pipes come together to form an automotive ribcage responsible for its outrageous horsepower, surpassing 717 to be exact.

Mike was first introduced to Matt Corish (one half of the Australian brother-duo responsible for engineering the V12 LS) through his good friend Rod Saboury at the 2015 East Coast Indoor Nationals. It wasn't until 2016 that he met Matt's brother Shane Cornish at SEMA, a pivotal event that Mike can only describe as "over the top;" the show propelled the V12 Camaro into a frenzy of aftermarket acclaim by press from around the world. Due to its terrific response, the first blocks of the new V12 LS production run are being finished up now and will be for sale to the public shortly. Not only has the car been instrumental in meeting people in the automotive industry, but it also serves as a great liaison in making friends.

Performing all of these modifications may have exaggerated the appearance of the Camaro, but Heim maintains it still has the soul of a '67. Take the wing windows for example. The 1967 Camaro was the only year that the vehicle came with them so after chopping the top, extensive adjustment was required to make them appear stock. In addition, the suicide doors were designed to operate without electric control (a big challenge, Mike notes). His solution? Hiding the door handles in the original side view mirrors, a tribute to the vehicle's history that is both clever and utilitarian.

Keeping the integrity of the Camaro is paramount to Mike — it is the first car he has ever owned. It was sold to him by his cousin, and his brother lent him the money to purchase it. 1991, the car was taken off the road for a repaint, but after stripping it down, Heim discovered other dilemmas and the Camaro went into hibernation. He proceeded with the restoration years later, designing it to look the way it does today (sans V12, which would come in 2015). Taking the car's past into account, one understands why an absolute overhaul is disingenuous. Instead, the mod straddles a threshold between tradition and heritage on one side with innovation and the pursuit of power on the other.

Heim is always thrilled to be a part of Chevrolet Nationals, continuously bringing impressive builds here since 2010 (the last being a Winfield award-winning 1948 Studebaker Truck). "I don't want to give away the surprise but I am sure you will see a difference from any of the pictures [you've seen online]," he alludes regarding the ongoing transformation of the Camaro that has transpired post-SEMA.
