



NPD Showfield Highlights



Participant Judging

All NPD Showfield participants must check in at the Guest Services building for their goody bag, dash card and participant ballot judging sheet. The judging format is by participant ballot. All NPD Showfield participants are to choose their favorite car from each class listed on their ballot Saturday 1-4 PM. Ballots are due by 4:15 PM. The three cars receiving the most votes in each class will be posted on the Winners' List Sunday morning. (See Winners' List & Awards.)

Celebrity Choice Judging

All NPD Showfield participants, including the Standard of Excellence Judged Class, are eligible for a Celebrity Choice Award. Celebrity Judges make their selections on Saturday by placing a certificate and sticker on the vehicles they choose. Awards available for pick-up on Sunday.

Carlisle Elite Judging

Our staff will choose ten vehicles from the showfield to receive Carlisle Elite awards on Friday. To be eligible, all you need to do is have your registered vehicle parked on the NPD Showfield. Winners are presented with their awards as they are selected.

Standard of Excellence **Judging**

Standard of Excellence (SOE) is a professionally judged NPD Showfield class in which the 15 top scoring vehicles receive award plaques and a Best of Show winner gets a cup trophy. SOE participants get their goody bag and dash card at the Guest Services building. Vehicles park in a reserved area on the showfield on Row IO. There is an additional fee for this judged class and space is limited. If space is available, vehicles may change their registration to this class at the Showfield Office in the Registration building outside Gate 3. Special thanks to eJudged.com for judging.

"This Car Matters" Award

The Historic Vehicle Association, or HVA, will choose a vehicle to receive their 'This Car Matters' award. It is a movement to collect, preserve and share stories that celebrate the automobile's historic impact on modern culture and the lives of everyday people (HistoricVehicle.org). Congratulations to the 2017 winner, a 1969 Chevrolet Camaro Blue Maxi.

Young Guns

"Young Guns" is a showfield class for owners age 25 and younger. It is open to all makes

and models of GM vehicles. Judging is by participant ballot, as described on this page.

Club Challenge & Coolest Club

Awards are given to the three clubs with the most registered showfield participants. The club with the coolest club activity, as determined by our staff, wins an award too.

Winners' List & Awards

Winners of the participant judging, celebrity choice judging, SOE judging, club challenge and Kids Choice Award will be posted on the Winners' List at 9 AM Sunday on our website and outside of Guest Services.

NPD Showfield participants must check the list, and if they have won, go inside Guest Services to pick up their award(s). Winners may choose to participate in the Awards Parade. Official award parade photos are taken by Eagle Productions Photography and will be for sale at their booth under the Grandstand.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO BE HERE **ON SUNDAY:**

60 YEARS OF THE IMPALA (Building T)





1958 CHEVROLET IMPALA MIKE KISSINGER

The Chevrolet Impala debuted in 1958 as one of Chevrolet's most expensive models and quickly became one of the best-selling passenger cars in the United States. In 1959 it was redesigned using bodyshells more like the Buicks, Oldsmobiles and Pontiacs of the time. In 1961 the Impala began its third generation on the GM B Platform which would last until 1964. In 1965, in its fourth generation, the Impala took the market by storm setting an all-time industry sales record of more than 1 million units in the U.S. By 1971

styling changed in the automotive market and, naturally, the Impala did as well by introducing its fifth-generation model. This lasted until 1976. In 1977, 1994, 2000, 2006 and 2014 the automotive market changed again, leading to sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth and tenth generation versions of the car which all scored well enough with consumers to continue this car's stake in the market.
