



Ramchargers

It seems as though the RAMCHARGERS enjoy being at Carlisle as much as we enjoy having them at the show and for that reason we call them our "friends" rather than special guests. Even though they have become regulars at the Chrysler Nationals, we can't forget what this group has done for our hobby. They were pioneers on the track and in the office. They truly are legends in the Mopar world and we are honored to have them at the show each year. RAMCHARGERS attending include Al Adam, Mike Buckel, Tom Coddington, Dick Jones, Dave Rockwell, Dick Skoglund and John Wehrly.

Golden Commandos

The Golden Commandos have made the Carlisle Chrysler Nationals a regular part of their summer plans and you should make meeting them at this year's show part of your plans too. Led by Ray Kobe, the Commandos will be part of this year's festivities where they'll meet with fans and sign autographs all weekend. Ray

is joined by Warren Anderson, Evan Ericson and Jim Hall. These legends are 2013 Mopar Hall of Fame inductees.

Herb McCandless

Herb McCandless earned the nickname "Mr. Four Speed" with his '65 Hemi Super Stock Dodge. He was enlisted as a driver and mechanic by the Sox & Martin team and ended up driving several of their more famous cars. Herb then went on to become one of the foremost car builders and drivers of Pro Stock in the early 70s before opening Herb McCandless Performance in North Carolina. Herb has always been eager to lend a helping hand to any Mopar enthusiast in need. Whether he's racing, wrenching or cruising in one of his muscle cars, Herb has consistently been reinventing the wheel and going out of his way to help as many people as he can.

"Mr. Norm" Kraus

In 1962 Norm Kraus opened Grand Spaulding Dodge in Chicago and within three years the dealership became the foremost dealer of high-performance Dodges. By the late 60s, "Mr. Norm's" in Chicago was selling more muscle cars than anvone else in the country and his "Mr. Norm's Sport Club" had gone international. The dealership closed in 1975, but Norm has remained active in the hobby, being involved with

everything from modified new Dodges to retro custom builds and everything in between.

Linda Vaughn

In an automotive world dominated by men, Linda Vaughn burst onto the scene in the early 60s. The First Lady of Motorsports, she was the trophy girl at all types of major motorsports including NHRA, Indy Car. Formula One and NASCAR. She's been crowned the queen of many different tracks, products and organizations, but her attachment to the Hurst brand in the 60s propelled the one-time dental assistant and local beauty to an international superstar. She was so popular that she did USO-type tours to Vietnam. Vaughn will meet fans, sign autographs, pose for photos and talk about her time in the automotive world.

Kevin Wesley

Kevin Wesley conquered Pikes Peak in Colorado in his 2018 Dodge Challenger SRT Hellcat Widebody race car. A run like that takes not only a talented driver, but a hooked-up car as well. Kevin has an impressive resume of competition and is the namesake of Wesley Motorsports. See Kevin and the car on the Midway, plus expect that he'll take it to the track at least once so you can see what the racing world has known for vears - this man can drive and this car is amazing!

2018 marks Mopar Collector's Guide's Seventh Annual Mopar Hall of Fame event. It is held Saturday at the Camp Hill Radisson, with check-in starting at 6:30 p.m. Seating is limited and tickets can be purchased at the Mopar Collector's Guide displays at the show located at D 86-89, G 91-92 and Q 20. SCCA Racers: Scott Harvey & Randy Graves

During the 60s Chrysler engineer Scott Harvey was driving Valiants and Barracudas in SCCA races. He finished second in the grueling 4,000 mile trans-Canada race in 1968 and won many off-road races. In 1975-76 he successfully raced Ramcharger trucks.

With his friend and driver Randy Graves, this dynamic duo continued to be a force to be reckoned with well into the late 70s. Many of the innovations they pioneered are still in use today.

Plymouth Rapid Transit System Caravan: **Bob Larivee &** Bill Moeller

At Chrysler's request, Bob Larivee headed the concept of the Plymouth Rapid Transit Caravan (PRTC) of 1970 and 1971 to showcase Plymouth's performance cars and speed equipment. It was a rolling car show of radical customs taken to dealerships across the country.

Bill Moeller was the cost and logistics man for making the Caravan a reality. Working directly with Chrysler and Larivee, Bill organized the events, kept everything on schedule and saw to it that the portable car show made it to hundreds of dealerships.

Steven Juliano

Steven is a true collector with a focus on factory promotional show cars and promotional items from the Scat Pack and Rapid Transit System eras. He also has a passion for unrestored Mopar survivors and anything unusual. He summed it up perfectly, "I don't own these cars or any of this stuff - I'm just taking care of them for whoever comes after me, and they better do the same." Steven is preserving history, and enjoying every minute.



Summers Brothers Racing Team: **Bob Summers & Bill Summers**

Bob and Bill Summers designed and built the legendary "Goldenrod" which was clocked at 409 mph in 1965 on the Bonneville Salt Flats. It held the record as the fastest wheel-driven speed for any car well into the 1990s! Regrettably, Bob passed away in 1992. Bill oversaw every inch of the Goldenrod's restoration.

Ernie Derr

Ernie Derr made his signature red-and-white Dodge stock cars legendary with 353 career racing victories from the 50s through 1975. In 1964

Chrysler lured him into their camp and he immediately won his first race behind the wheel of a Dodge. He later switched to Plymouth and racked up 27 wins in his first season. 1969 was the pinnacle of Ernie's success when he won an astonishing 25 of the 30 IMCA national events.

Tom Tignanelli

"Tig" was a longtime Chrysler Race Group engineer who was famous for his radical custom A/FX Plymouth known as the "UFO." Built primarily for match and exhibition racing, the famous orange-and-black Plymouth soon became a rolling test bed for Chrysler performance parts. He went on to have a series of "UFO" funny cars, and became part of the Mopar Missile Pro Stock team in the early 70s. Tom left a huge footprint on the world of drag racing and Mopar performance.

Bob McDaniel

Bob started his 25-year career with Chrysler in 1954 in the Plymouth Service Division. In the early 60s he raced Super Stocks, was involved with the Mobil Gas Economy Run and Bonneville jet cars. In 1964, he transferred to Detroit into Product Planning with the circle racing group and ran the marine racing program.

1968 Hemi Super Stock **Package Cars**

The concept of a literal assembly line to build drag cars, not legal for street use, and buy them directly from the factory or a dealership had never been entertained before Chrysler teamed up with Hurst Engineering. This is the 50th Anniversary of the world's first "production" drag race cars.

50 YEARS OF THE DODGE SUPER BEE (Building T)

In 1968 Dodge introduced the Super Bee to compete with the other manufacturers' street racers and the Plymouth Road Runner. It was initially offered with the 383 four-barrel with the 426 Hemi as an option then the A12 package was available in mid-1969. The A12 included a 440 Six Pack, lift-off fiberglass hood and 15" steel wheels with chrome lug nuts. In 1971 the Super Bee package was offered on the redesigned Charger. While Plymouth continued on with the Road Runner in various forms until 1980, Dodge ended the Super Bee after the 1971 model year. It was resurrected with the Rumble Bee trucks of 2004-05, which were pretty cool in their own right, but then in 2007 the Super Bee name made a comeback.

50 YEARS OF THE ROAD RUNNER (Building T)

Although many options were available over the years, the original intent of the Plymouth Road Runner was to be no-frills performance. The 383 four-barrel was the base engine or an optional 426 Hemi. During the 1969 model year the 440 Six Barrel was developed for the "street racer" and was part of the A12 package. For 1970, the 440 became an option when the Superbird was developed for NASCAR competition. In 1971, as with the Super Bee, the Road Runner became similar to an E-Body even though it was still a B-Body. This was also the first year you could get a small block 340. From 1972-74 if you wanted a 440 you had to get the GTX package. The 1975 Road Runner was based on the then-new Fury. When the new F-Body Volare

arrived for 1976 the Road Runner found its home there until 1980.

The 340 made its debut in the 1968 model year of Darts and Barracudas making these compact models real performers in the small block wars. The 340 kept the price down as well as the weight on the nose resulting in a combination that was quick and well balanced. It always came with good heads, big valves, a hot cam, performance exhaust manifolds and at least a four-barrel. Factory 340 Mopars may still be viewed as "budget muscle cars" but they are pretty stout performers and deserve to be honored for being a great engine overall.

Stiles assisted Jere Stahl and Dave Strickler to many victories on the guarter mile. For the '70 season, Bill moved to Pro Stock with a Duster that he ran until 1973. He was later known as an expert in preparing magneto ignition systems for racing applications out of his shop, Stiles Performance, in York, PA.


