

Gary Bartlett

Gary Bartlett is one of the foremost experts in classic Jaguar restorations. He started the company OSJI (Original Specification Jaguar Interiors) in 1980 and has since hand-crafted some of the top Jaguar interiors down to the finest detail. Gary is also involved with Muncie Imports & Classics, a top European and Asian vehicle restoration shop located in Muncie, Indiana.

Joseph Limongelli

Published author, Velocity Channel TV host and overall car enthusiast Joseph Limongelli will be debuting and signing his new book on Aston Martins. Joey is the emcee for the roundtable discussion and will be talking about his next book, "Me and My Jaguar." Michael Quinn

Michael Quinn is the grandson of Sir William

Lyons, the founder of Jaguar Cars, and son of Pat Appleyard, a multiple winner of international rallies in the early 1950s (in her famous Jaguar XK120 registered NUB120). He worked at the famous Jaguar dealer in London, RA Creamer & Son, for 30 years holding positions from Mechanic to Dealer Principal.

Dave Welsh

David Welsh is the General Manager of Welsh Enterprises and son of Bill Welsh, founder of the company. Welsh Enterprises has been supplying Jaguar parts and accessories for over 40 years. It has the largest inventory of parts for 1949-present day Jaguars including Welsh-manufactured parts, used, rebuilt and rare OEM parts.

About Aston Martin*

Aston Martin is a British sports car brand founded in 1913 by Lionel Martin and Robert Bamford. It is known for its style, luxury, performance and exclusivity. Over the past century, the marque has stayed true to the original values of Lionel Martin, who believed that an Aston Martin must be "a quality car of good performance and appearance. A car for the discerning owner driver with fast touring in mind, designed, developed, engineered and built as an individual".

Aston Martin currently offers five models: Vantage, DB11, Rapide S, Vanquish S, and Valkyrie. Boasting a top speed of 205mph, the V12

Vantage S became the fastest production Aston Martin in the firm's history, with the exception of the ultra-exclusive One-77. In contrast, Rapide S combines Aston Martin's characteristic performance with the practicality of four seats, cloaked in one of the most graceful bodies.

Built on a heritage of GT racing and culminating in an historic victory in the 1959 Le Mans 24 Hours with the DBR1, Aston Martin returned to competitive motorsports in 2005. Consecutive GT1 class wins at Le Mans in 2007 and 2008 followed, as well as a fourth place finish in 2009 with a new LMP1 car, the fastest petrol car in the field. In 2009, the V12 Vantage claimed a class victory at the Nürburgring 24-hour race on its race debut, with 2013 welcoming the world's first Hybrid-Hydrogen race car to be raced at an international event in the form of a Rapide S, piloted, amongst others, by CEO Dr. Bez. The Nürburgring remains the definitive engineering sign-off test for all Aston Martin road cars. Aston Martin continues to race in the GTE classes of the World Endurance Championship.

About |aguar*

The first Jaguar car was produced in 1935 in the United Kingdom. The company was founded by Sir William Lyons and he insisted that every car the company produced combined performance and beauty like no other. His uncompromising vision set benchmarks that Jaguar still follows.

Jaguar currently offers seven models: F-Pace (SUV), E-Pace (SUV), I-Pace (electric SUV), F-Type (2-seat sports car), XE (sports sedan), XF (luxury sedan and wagon), and XJ (premium luxury sedan).

Jaguar racing heritage began just after World War II and continues today. The XK120 put Jaguar on the map and was the fastest production car of the time. NUB120 was driven by lan Applevard. with his wife Patricia "Pat" Lyons, the daughter of Jaquar founder Sir William Lyons, as his co-driver. They achieved three consecutive Alpine Rally wins, something never repeated in the race's 39 vear history.

While the XK120 was ruling the mountains, the track was under the command of the C-type which achieved the first Jaguar 24 hours of Le Mans victory in 1951. D-types saw victories in the later 1950s as well as broke the circuit speed record.

Though not purpose built racers, the Mark I and II excelled on the touring car circuit - where everyday road cars went head to head. These races made a name for the Jaguar small sedans between 1958 and 1963.

Born in 1982, the XJR-5 was a mid-engined, V12-powered racing prototype with an aluminium honey-comb monocoque, mid-mounted engine, and trademark green and white colouring. It finished third on its racing debut. In the 1980s, the XJR-8 claimed many victories and returned Jaguar to the top of the Le Mans podium for the first time since 1957.

After experience on the Formula 1 circuit in the early 2000s Jaguar has returned to the racing stage. Formula E puts an emphasis on innovative technology, and it's the ideal platform to test electric technologies and hone expertise for the future of Jaguar's vehicles.

80 YEARS OF THE VOLKSWAGEN BEETLE (Building T)

The idea behind the Volkswagen Beetle was to build an affordable and practical car. "Volks" means "people's" in German, thus Volkswagen literally means "people's car." The economical car with the rear-mounted, air-cooled engine was produced from 1938 to 2003 and became an icon. The "new" style of Beetle was introduced in 1998 and variations are still in production today.





Judging Standards:



Exterior

Body & Paint:



This category is based on panel alignment & straightness, body kit (fitment, rarity of product, etc), paint/glass condition, shaving, body part or lighting conversions, wide body, and/or any other custom bodywork.

Suspension:



Type of suspension (static/air/etc). Also taking into consideration: attention to detail, ride height, undercarriage upgrades, fitment and finish of products, powdercoating/plating, install of air components.

Brakes:



The judges are looking for big brake or custom brake upgrades. Are both the front and rear upgraded? Quality and rarity of product? Also taking into consideration any other braking accessories, brake lines, and custom finishes on the braking system.

Wheels & Tires:



This category focuses on the uniqueness, rarity, and fitment of the wheels and tires. Also taking into consideration cleanliness and custom finishes.

Overall Quality:



This category focuses on the overall execution of the vehicle's exterior. Scores will be based on attention to detail, use of color & unique finishes, graphics, quality of finish, accessory lighting, and cleanliness.

Engine Bay

Appearance & Performance:



This category focuses on engine bolt-ons, custom fabrication, aspiration (turbo/supercharger/etc), motor swap, use of paint and or custom plating/finishing, cleanliness of wiring, nitrous oxide, accessories.

Overall Execution:



Craftsmanship is key in this category. Judges will evaluate safety upgrades, performance engineering, one-off/custom parts, attention to detail, quality of plating/polishing/finishes, and most importantly level of difficulty (ie motor swap, turbo, shaved bay, wire tuck, rhd or rwd conversions, etc).

Interior

Passenger Compartment: 10 POINTS



This category focuses on the seating area - taking into consideration the condition and quality of dash, seats, accessories, unique features, roll cage or roll bar(s), use of fabric/materials, and overall upholstery.

10) POINTS Trunk -**Entertainment vs. Motorsport Theme**

This is a progressive judging category which takes into consideration the theme of the vehicle build. In this category, motorsport or performance themed vehicles do not lose points for not including a custom audio/video install.

Audio/Show Car themed vehicles will be scored based on In Car Entertainment, audio install (visual), video sources and tv/monitors, quality/rarity of products, air suspension components installed in cargo area, etc.

Motorsport/Performance themed vehicles will be scored based on fuel cell install, roll cage components in trunk or rear suspension area, suspension components, strut bars, braces, safety equipment, quality/rarity of products, etc.

Overall Quality:



Attention to detail, use of color/finishes, materials, fitment, cleanliness, fabrication, level of customization.

Show Quality



The Show Quality portion of the scoresheet is a comprehensive look at the build's overall execution and style. These two categories are judged based on the universal 5-star rating system. Those possible 10 stars count as the final 10 points of your overall score.

Originality/Uniqueness:



Rare vehicles or more common vehicles with unique modifications and rare parts will score higher.

Overall Execution:



Overall quality of build. Fitment throughout all aspects of vehicle. Does the vehicle flow? Is it period or era correct? Is it relevant to current trends? Is the vehicle still functional?

The overall score is based on a possible 100 TOTAL POINTS.

Judging Standards (continued):



Stock, Restored & Preserved Vehicles:

Due to the unique format of Carlisle's Import & Performance Nationals, not all vehicles will fit strictly into the official "Judging Standards" score sheet. Vehicles that have been purposely kept stock for restoration or preservation purposes will be judged on slightly different criteria. All drivers must consider that they are competing against a flawless version of their build on a score sheet, rather than against the other competitors in their class, whether the vehicle is stock, subtle, or aggressively modified. Some classes may include both stock and modified vehicles.

Restored and preserved vehicles will be judged on the same visual areas of their vehicles – Exterior, Engine Compartment, Interior/Trunk, Overall Execution, etc. Deductions can be given for imperfections in paint/materials, scratches, general dirty upkeep, etc. Further deductions can be given for bolt-ons and custom modifications as well. If you are building a restoration project, you must keep in mind that all aspects of the build must be "period correct" for age of the vehicle. A properly restored vehicle should now once again have the appearance of a show room vehicle from its original production date – with zero or few aftermarket modifications. A preserved vehicle may show some age, but should still overall maintain its factory show room appearance. Replacement parts should be "period correct" and should be OEM equipment.

Deductions and scoring will be weighed accordingly, so that stock (restored and preserved) vehicles that appear in the same classes as modified vehicles, will be considered on a level playing field for placement within the final results. The event judging staff has gone through a training and selection process to be a part of this event.




rest is history."


