
### Awards



1961 CORVETTE CONVERTIBLE 283/270 HP RP0468 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2017 JOHN KEANE

John became the second owner of this 1960 Corvette in August 1961. He enjoyed it on drives to beach, the tracks and the mountains. One cold wintry Christmas Eve, even though it was dressed with studded snow tires, it had to be rescued by a local fire department. After 44 years he decided it was time for a restoration. It has over 98% of its original parts, however, it took some dedicated prep work to bring it back to its present status.

Honors include: Bloomington Gold SURVIVOR, Gold and Benchmark. NCRS Duntov Mark of Excellence and 5-Star Bowtie (One of four C1's to receive both awards.) MCACN (Muscle Car & Corvette Nationals) Vintage Certified to the level of "Legend".



1964 CORVETTE SPORT COUPE 327/375 HP L84 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2014 CHRISTIAN AND CYNTHIA MEYER

When he was 19 years old, the original owner convinced his parents to purchase a new 1964 fuel-injected Corvette for him (we should all be so lucky). Louis polished it often and only took it out for drives on nice days, until 14 years later when he moved to a rural location with a dirt road. He couldn't endure the thought of driving it on a dirt road, so he reluctantly sold it. With the assistance of a few subsequent like-minded owners, the car was preserved in its current condition.



1966 CORVETTE CONVERTIBLE 427/425 HP L72 BENCHMARK AWARD - 1991 LINDA STROHM-DUNLAP

Linda's late husband, Carl Strohm, purchased this original, unrestored 1966 Corvette in 1980 from its original owner.

In 1991, the car was displayed at the Bloomington Gold Special Collection, where it also received Gold Certification, SURVIVOR and Benchmark awards. In 2016, it returned to Bloomington Gold for the 1966-2016 50th Anniversary display. Additional awards include the NCRS Duntov Mark of Excellence and 5-Star Bowtie.

Created in 1978, Bloomington Gold's judging goal was to enable any Corvette to be a winner, provided it met high standards of authenticity. Gold Certified® would require Corvettes to be judged not against one another, but as to the individual car's level of accuracy compared to the day it left the factory. A Corvette would earn Gold Certification if its condition was within 95 to 100 percent of the way it rolled off the assembly line - no better, no worse. Being 100 percent factory authentic, though, did not mean the car was 100 percent perfect, because Corvettes weren't perfect when they left the factory. A group of judges was assembled from the nation's most knowledgeable Corvette experts and the National Corvette Certification Board was created.



1967 CORVETTE CONVERTIBLE 427/400 HP L68 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2016 LARRY SACHS

This Corvette is optioned with speedminder, shoulder harness, transistor ignition, factory side exhaust and a 370 rear axle. The car was purchased in November 1966 by Thomas Bleauskas. After a long ownership, Bleauskas sold the car to the late Dana Pope, a very well known, astute, respected local Corvette enthusiast. After a few years, Pope sold the car to Peter Borchert. During Peter's ownership from the late 90s he bravely and neatly removed the original gas tank sticker. After a few years of ownership, Borchert sold the car to its current owner 15 years ago. The car showed 31,000 original miles and has only been driven 4,000 miles since then.

The car received numerous NCRS Top Flight awards and the Bloomington Gold Benchmark Award.

CHIP'S CHOICE #395

1968 CORVETTE COUPE 327/350 HP L79 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2019 THOMAS ELIAS SUGAR

This 1968 Corvette was delivered to Eugene Rambler on July 31st, 1968. Rally Red with black leather interior, it is powered by the venerable

327/350 HP L79 through the M20 4-speed transmission, 3.55 Positraction Rear Axle, and Off-road Exhaust, Notably optioned, including rear window defroster, speed warning indicator and full transistor ignition, and wrestled (Thomas bought the car in 15 seconds!) from the personal collection of Kevin Mackay, this four owner, highly original all lacquer coupe's time capsule condition belies its 55,000 northeast miles. The Corvette still rides on OEM PT6 F70-15 Goodyear red striped tires and sports a set of 1968-only PO1 full wheel covers. During the past year, and within a whirlwind three month span, (which has to be a record) the Corvette received an NCRS Top Flight, the MCACN Concours Gold and Triple Diamond, and Bloomington SURVIVOR, Gold Certificate and Benchmark awards.



1971 CORVETTE COUPE 454/425 HP LS6 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2000 LINDA STROHM-DUNLAP

Linda and her late husband Carl purchased this Corvette in 1973. Despite the gas price war and big block Corvettes depreciating, he had to have this car as soon as he heard the reverberating exhaust. Carl knew the LS6 engine was very special, but didn't really know how rare. (Only 188 from a total production of 21,801.)

In 2000 the Corvette was invited to the Bloomington Gold Special Collection, where it received Gold Certification, SURVIVOR and the Benchmark awards. The Corvette also earned NCRS Duntov Mark of Excellence and 5-Star Bowtie awards. The LS6 was featured on the cover of the Vette Vues Fact Book 1968-72 Corvettes and in Corvette, The Legend Lives On 1968-86.

For 1990, Bloomington Gold added another milestone judging event: SURVIVOR®. The judging and certification for unrestored Corvettes. "Worn In, But Not Worn Out" became the theme as Corvettes at least twenty years old were judged in four categories for their originality. As with Gold Certification judging, these original Corvettes are not judged against other cars, but reviewed individually against the factory standard.

In 1991, Bloomington Gold introduced the ultimate and most demanding judging goal: The Benchmark® Award. To achieve Benchmark an unrestored Corvette must receive Gold Certification and pass all four categories of SURVIVOR during the same weekend. To date, over 400 Corvettes have received the prestigious Benchmark Award.

1972 CORVETTE CONVERTIBLE 350/200 HP L48 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2012 CHRISTIAN AND CYNTHIA MEYER

The original owner (Anne) met Elliott Marantette "Pete" Estes, then president of the Chevrolet division of GM, during a reception in 1971. Anne told Mr. Estes of her dream to someday own a Corvette. The following week, a loaner Corvette appeared at Anne's home with instructions to enjoy it for a month, courtesy of Mr. Estes. When Anne returned the loaner Corvette, she indicated her interest in ordering a new Corvette, but only if it was painted black at the factory. The story is unclear as to how Mr. Estes was involved in the process of procuring the only documented factory black Corvette in 1972, but Anne got her wish.



1972 CORVETTE CONVERTIBLE 350/200 HP L48 BENCHMARK AWARD - 2018 STEVE AND WENDY BURNS

This 1972 Corvette was delivered new at Lloyd Bridges Chevrolet in Chelsea, Michigan on July 28th, 1972 finished in Targa blue paint, black vinyl interior, and a black top. Power comes from the base L48 engine backed by the M20 4-speed transmission. Options include a vinyl hardtop, power brakes, AM/FM stereo, and tilt/telescopic steering column.

This 5-owner car remains largely unrestored and shows just over 31,000 miles. It retains nearly all of its original paint, interior, top, and chassis components.

To date, the car has claimed some of the top awards in the Corvette hobby. After a Bloomington Survivor award in 1992 it claimed Survivor, Gold, and Benchmark honors in 2018 and participated in the 2019 Gold Collection. Other recent awards include NCRS Top Flight and 4-Star Bowtie, plus MCACN Concourse Gold and Triple Diamond. Its entire judging career has been published in CorvetteBlogger.com's popular "On the Campaign Trail" series.



1978 CORVETTE

1978 marked the first year for the Chevrolet Corvette to pace the Indianapolis 500. Chevrolet announced they were going to build only 500 Pace car replicas. Rumors of this limited production and media attention resulted in many buyers paying above list price. Chevrolet revised production numbers to 6502. This allowed one for every dealer in the U.S. and Canada and a group of track cars.

Pace Car #2487 was one of only 220 four speed cars and was equipped with the higher horsepower L82 engine. The car was sold new at Burns Chevrolet in Idaho and has under 1900 original miles.

The car has been awarded Bloomington Gold Benchmark, NCRS 5 Star Bowtie, and MCACN Triple Diamond.



1990 CORVETTE ZR1 S/N 00019 RICK HENDRICK

The ZR-1 Corvette was a performance icon of the '90s, with the high-tech muscle to back up its supercar reputation. Despite its low build volume - a total of 6,939 cars were produced between 1990 and 1995 - this is the car that helped reestablish the Corvette as a legitimate world-class performance car. It's a distinction the Corvette hasn't relinquished since.

This 1990 ZR-1 is car #19 built and was delivered personally to Rick Hendrick by Jim Perkins at the Bowling Green assembly plant. This historic Corvette was bestowed with Bloomington Gold 7 Generations honors as well as being a 2012 Great Hall Inductee. The ZR-1 looks like a Corvette. There's that unmistakable shape but with a notable difference - both in styling and engineering.

The ZR-1 featured a three-inch wider rear track, necessitated by its oversize 315/35-17 rear tires. The change required new doors, as well as a new rear fascia that took a convex shape and included new rectangular tail lamps to distinguish it from lesser Corvettes. Under the hood is what really sets the ZR-1 apart. Unique to the ZR-1 is the LT5 engine developed jointly with Lotus and built by Mecury Marine. This 5.7-liter aluminum, 32-valve V8 was ahead of its time and produced an impressive 375 horsepower in 1990 famously assigning the moniker "King of the Hill" to the ZR-1 Corvette. The ZR-1 quickly became the fastest production Corvette GM had ever built in the model's history reaching a top speed of 180 mph and today is a highly coveted member of the Corvette community.

In the future, we'll probably look at 2020 as the year we'd all like to forget. But, since we are still living this Groundhog Day lifestyle, let us reflect on 50 years ago; 1970. This year we spotlight Corvettes of 1970 and that means year three of production for the C3. For the '70 version, fender flares were designed into the body contours to reduce wheel-thrown debris damage. The exhaust outlets were made larger and transitioned from round to rectangular in shape, there was a ZR1 package introduced as was an all-new LT-1/350 cubic inch small block V8 which offered 370 horsepower. The '70 C3 LT-1 managed the quarter mile in 14.36 seconds at topped 101.69 miles per hour. According to Motor Trend at the time "There is Corvette and there is Porsche. One is the best engineering effort of America, the other of Germany. The difference in machines is not as great as the disparity in price."

The '70 display may also take you back to a younger you, either old enough to be doing your own thing or still riding around with mom and dad – using dad's well-placed arm as a seat belt. Nixon was still a few years removed from Watergate, so in theory, all is good in the White House. In fact, Elvis came to visit in December of that year. Wouldn't you have liked to have been a fly on the wall for that conversation?

1970 offered enough "coolness" that in 2015, CNN posted a gallery of some historic moments from that year. While not all of them, here is a list of a few:

· As space continued to fascinate mankind,

NASA launched Apollo 13 with the intention of a third moon landing but issues during launch meant a crash landing in the South Pacific on April 17.

- Four dead in Ohio was not just the hook of popular Crosby, Stills, Nash and Young song, it was a sad fact of life. On May 4, members of the Ohio National Guard opened fire on Kent State students protesting the Vietnam war.
- Oh, and for the music fans at the show today, the Billboard Hot 100 singles Top 5 are as follows:
  - "Bridge Over Troubled Waters" Simon & Garfunkel
  - 2) "Close to You" The Carpenters
  - 3) "American Woman" The Guess Who
  - 4) "Raindrops Keep Falling on My Head"– B.J. Thomas
  - 5) "War" Edwin Starr
- The Beatles released their final album, "Let it Be" on May 8. The release date came just one month after the group's announced break up. Two singers that are now viewed as iconic passed away; Jimi Hendrix and Janis Joplin were both 27 when they died, less than a month apart.
- Moving on to births; actors Matt Damon, Kevin Smith, Melissa McCarthy, Uma Thurman, Shemar Moore and Sarah Silverman were all born in 1970. In addition,

- A gallon of gas cost \$0.36, the average cost to attend a four-year public school was \$405 per year and \$1,792 for private, the average cost of a new home was \$23,450, a postage stamp was \$0.06, we celebrated our first Earth Day and both 2020 and 1970 both started with the Kansas City Chiefs winning the Super Bowl.
- Cars were a hot commodity but the Boeing 747 also made its first commercial flight across the pond to London.

Oh...and in 1970, August 27-30 was the same then as it is now, Thursday through Sunday.

### A 46-Year Family Restoration Project

Every summer, guests flock to Corvettes at Carlisle in droves to show off their Corvette or see the thousands of Corvettes that are on display. If you are here to look, it's fair to assume that one (or more) of them catches your eye for one reason or the other. If you are here to show your Corvette on the Fun Field that automotive relationship you have may be deeper than what the guests can see. Your love is more than just the car. Your Corvette has history, stories and family ties that make you part of the Corvette and the Corvette a part of you.

This weekend, we are pleased to welcome John Przybyla and his family to Corvettes at Carlisle. John is from Johnstown, Pennsylvania and has been coming to Carlisle since 1975. We first heard about John from his daughter Marie via our Corvettes at Carlisle Facebook page. She shared a great story about his Corvette. The story embodies what we are all about at Corvettes at Carlisle and who better to share that story than Marie herself.

"When my father, John Przybyla graduated from high school, a buddy got a brand-new Corvette and my father vowed that one day he would have one too. His opportunity came in 1974. My father was driving from Hagerstown, MD to Waynesboro, PA when he spotted a 1959 Corvette sitting alongside Foose's Garage. The car was there because some friends would work

together to repair it after races. Dad immediately asked his brother-in-law to stop so they could look at it. The car had no motor because it had gotten blown up while drag racing and the hood had a hole cut in it for the blower that had been sticking out of it. The guys agreed to sell my dad the car. I was six at the time and a "daddy's girl," so I kind of grew up with and in that car.

Dad hauled the car back to Johnstown where we lived and found a 283 motor for it and started to get the car road ready. Having one daughter and another on the way was financially strapping so my father put the car together the best he could. He always put his family first, but still kept his dream alive. Each year he would go to Corvettes at Carlisle and buy parts for the day when he could restore the car properly. As a family though we enjoyed driving the Vette as she was. Some people called her a rat rod but to me, it was just dad's Corvette. Mom and dad's Corvette fever continued, as they joined the Flood City Corvette Club and were very active. While dad was at work, mom would fire up the car and take us for picnics to local and regional state parks. While far from restored, the car ALWAYS turned heads. Dad's dream remained to one day fully restore the car and his desire grew a little more after discovering a blue color under the taillights. Assuming its original color was blue with black interior, dad would always tell his buddies

(or 40+ years) that one day he would restore the car. They just kept saying 'sure.'

As my parents aged mom finally told dad that it was time to get to work on our bucket list. Of course the Corvette was at the top of this list! Dad found a body shop to paint his Vette, but to keep the cost down my fiancé and I along with Dad did as much as we could to strip the car down. In October of 2015 dad brought the car to my place in Boonsboro, MD and we got started. From overhauling the engine to stripping the paint, I felt so blessed to have been able to help and share in this experience with my dad. It was always pretty clear that someday the car would be mine, so that made it extra special!

After stripping the car down, we realized that under layer after layer of paint was its true original color; white...and the interior was blue! Our next move was to take the car to a body shop. The experience was horrible and cost us a lot of money for next to nothing. The lack of professionalism from the shop owner cost us three years of project time.

Once we got the car back and after a lot of research, I connected with Zayne Finney in Hancock, MD. Zayne wasn't able to do the car himself, but said he would personally help me find the right guy to do it. His efforts led us to Dave Cauffman and he turned out to be the perfect fit for us. We brought the car to the Hagerstown area

to get restored. Dave did such an amazing job as did Joe Nolan, who worked on the interior and the rag top. Both guys knew Gordon Foose and were familiar with his garage. Joe even thought he might have dad's original hood with the hole in it. What a small world.

On March 27, 2020 dad FINALLY got to pick up his Corvette; IT WAS DONE! I think he is still in disbelief that it's actually finished. Factor in the damper that the Coronavirus has put on everything, and its debut wasn't met with much of a bang...more of a fizzle. With everything being cancelled to date, we are excited about the prospect of showing it off at Corvettes at Carlisle. This is the first time that dad really gets to show off his dream.

With dad turning 80 this year, he has transferred ownership to me, but this car is still 'his' until the day he passes. I feel fortunate to have both him and the car to create as many memories together as possible! So many of my memories are at Carlisle with my dad and I am confident that this year will be the best one yet!"

She was also titled the "cool mom" for allowing her son to have all of his computer gaming friends over to have gaming parties. Elaine always wanted to know who her kid's friends were and took many of them in as her own because that is just who she was, a kind and caring soul. Tim and Elaine were married for 43 years and were together for a total of 51 years. Their story is a beautiful one about how love can conquer the challenges of life. Elaine truly was an incredible person.

We want to ensure Elaine's memory continues on. We ask everyone do 2 things. First, continue to promote and grow the Corvette hobby just as she did by volunteering at Corvette shows, serving in your local Corvette groups, hosting seminars, etc. Find a way a way to get involved. Secondly and most importantly, go spread kindness. Instead of saying "let me know what I can do to help," go be a doer, figure out how you can help someone, how you can make someone's day brighter and go do it.
