First Woman to take on Colorado's Pikes Peak in a Corvette

Although it is 2025, there are still firsts being achieved by women in motorsports. One might argue that there are no more firsts, but just look at Tracy Gaudu. She is the first woman to attempt the Pikes Peak International Hill Climb in a Corvette-her 2008 Z06 Corvette, to be more specific. Gaudu already has an impressive racing résumé, such as 3x NASA (National Auto Sport Association) Champion, 2023 SCCA Appalachian Hillclimb Series Modified Unlimited Champion, and many more.

Tracy has always loved Corvettes, ever since she was a little girl, but never thought she would be able to afford one. She purchased her first 2005 C6. joined the Longhorn Corvette Club in Austin, Texas, and began taking part in autocross competitions. She fell in love with autocross and began to dream about competing in the Pikes Peak competition. It is no easy task to wake up one day and decide to do it-there is a lot of hard work and preparation that goes into it. She would watch the races online, and although she wanted to enter, there was a voice in her head telling her she wasn't ready and doubting her own abilities.

She kept her dream to herself until the end of last year because the voices in her head were so critical. Then finally, she decided to mention the idea to Ken Lingenfelter. His excitement toward the news made Tracy realize the worst they could say

was no.

To no surprise, she was accepted and immediately began picturing her car driving up the peak. She thought it was cool that she would be the first woman to drive a Corvette up the mountain, but that was not the main reason she entered. For her, it was to be "the fastest Corvette." After all, it is America's sports car racing up America's mountain.

In order for her to take on this race, she had to drop out of others she had previously signed up for. She was already entering the game late and needed all the preparation time she could gather. She needed to fundraise to make sure her car was in the right shape to take on this challenge. The one sponsor she was banking on fell through, and the Longhorn Corvette Club put together a GoFundMe for Tracy. She is a person who likes to do everything herself, but with the amount of time and effort that goes into this race, she needed the help of her friends. All the funds she raised, and her own money, went into the car to make sure it could climb up a 14,115foot mountain with steep falloffs.

Once she got there, she had three days to practice the course-but there was a twist. At no point was she allowed to take a run up the whole mountain. There were three days and three different sections to the track, so she was only able to practice one part of the mountain per day. She was also very sleep-deprived; she needed to get up

at 2 a.m., be at the gate by 3:30 a.m., attend the drivers' meeting at 5 a.m., finish her runs by 8:30 a.m., and be off the mountain by 9 a.m. when the public started to show up.

The course is no Sunday drive. In fact, it is 12.4 twisting and turning miles and has 156 turns. No matter who you are, this was not going to be an easy race. Tracy was ready for it: she thrives on adrenaline.

The day of the race had finally come, and Tracy was starting to feel the pressure of her run coming up. It was extremely windy—to the point that they repeatedly delayed the start time. After the wind had knocked over the strapped-down portaiohns, they cut the race short. The wind was blowing 80-100 mph and throwing rocks all over the place. The race ended at the start of the second section. Tracy understood, but was frustrated because, based on practice times, she would have been faster than Rob Holland's Corvette record.

Although the race did not go as she planned, she will be doing it again in 2026 and will begin preparing for it by the end of the year to give herself more time.

You have a great opportunity to meet her this weekend at Corvettes at Carlisle. This will be Tracy's first time attending, and she will be bringing her Atomic Orange Z06, so you'll be able to see it up close. This is a piece of Corvette history you do not want to miss.



The 1975 Corvette marked a transitional year for America's sports car, as it became the last model year to feature the distinctive "Stingray" badge and rear window design before a major styling refresh. Under the hood, the base engine was a 165-horsepower L48 350 cubic inch V8, while the optional L82 version produced 205 horsepower both figures reflecting the impact of increasingly strict emissions regulations that were reshaping the automotive industry.

The year 1975 was pivotal in American history, witnessing the fall of Saigon in April that marked the end of the Vietnam War, while domestically the country grappled with economic recession and the aftermath of Watergate. Popular culture saw the release of "Jaws," which became the first summer blockbuster, and Saturday Night Live premiered on television. The year also brought technological milestones with the founding of Microsoft by Bill Gates and Paul Allen, and the first personal computer, the Altair 8800, going on sale. Meanwhile, the disco era was in full swing, with hits like "Love Will Keep Us Together" by Captain & Tennille dominating the charts.

TERRY SHANHOLZ: 2024 Corvettes at Carlisle People's Choice **Best of Show Winner Driven by Aerolarri Wheels**

Each August at Corvettes at Carlisle, we showcase some of the best Corvettes around, both on the Fun Field and as part of our popular Aerolarri Wheels People's Choice - Best in Show contest. The process is simple enough-submit a photo of your car and some basic

info, have it posted to Facebook, and let the voting unfold. If you're lucky enough, you just might make it to the finals, which take place in person during Corvettes at Carlisle. Better yet, you might be the winner-and that's exactly what happened last August with Terry Shanholtz.

Terry is a proud native of Shanks, West Virginia, where he's made his living as a self-employed logger for over 50 years. His strong work ethic and love of the outdoors have defined much of his life-but nothing means more to him than his family.

Terry met his wife, Beverly, in Romney, WV, and together they built a life rooted in love, hard work, and shared values. Along the way, they raised four sonsthree of whom still live in West Virginia, while one has settled in Illinois. Their greatest joy has been watching their family grow, especially as their sons have blessed them with five wonderful grandchildren.

Beyond being a devoted husband, dad, and grandpa, Terry has a passion for car shows, antiquing, and more hobbies than anyone could count. Each September, Terry and his family host a local car show at Romney Cycles, a tradition that brings together community, family, and a shared love for classic cars. The grandchildren are a big part of the event, proudly handing out the "Kid's Pick" trophies each year. And



for at least one lucky grandchild, the highlight of the day is riding home in the Corvette with Pappy-a memory they all treasure.

Terry's love of cars has clearly rubbed off on his sons. All of them share some level of interest in the hobby, and one has even turned that passion into a career as an auto technician. Whether it's in the shop, the woods, or surrounded by family at a car show, Terry's life is a reflection of commitment, tradition, and the simple joys of doing what you love with the people you love most.

His Corvette iournev began when he first visited the Carlisle Fairgrounds in 1974. At the time, he didn't yet own a Corvette, but that changed in 1979 when he purchased a 1974 blue convertible coupe. He continued coming back to Carlisle year after year, looking for parts, inspiration, and knowledge about the Corvette legacy.

In 2009, Terry bought his first 1966 Corvette Coupe and restored it. He brought it to Corvettes at Carlisle in 2010 and won his first Celebrity Choice Award, selected by Ray Krawczyk. Though Corvettes at Carlisle had been a staple since 1982, this was Terry's first time showing a car. "That car, with the license plate 66 COUPE, remains one of my proudest builds," Terry says.

In 2011, Terry made a decision that would shape the rest of his Corvette journey—he joined the 1963-1967 Corvette Registry at

Carlisle, From that moment on, he's enjoyed every minute of it.

In 2014, Terry bought another 1966 Corvette Coupe, this time a project car from Battle Creek, Michigan. It took him almost three years to finish the restoration. When he first got it, the car was dismantled and in boxes. Originally, it was


Sunfire Yellow with a black vinyl interior. Terry stripped the frame and had it powder-coated, replaced nearly every part—from brake lines to A-arm bushings—and upgraded the interior with saddle leather. He added a vintage air system and a teak steering wheel. The finishing touch was a custom pearl blue paint job, completed by Kroon Kustoms in Somerset, PA.

In the spring of 2017, the car was finally ready—and Terry began racking up first-place trophies, cash prizes, and Best of Show honors between his two Corvettes.

"What started as a personal passion has become a deeply fulfilling hobby," said Terry. "I'm 71 years old, and this is THE coolest Corvette or automotive prize I've ever won." He continued, "Chet at Aerolarri Wheels has been great to work with. From our first conversation to when the wheels arrived, I couldn't have asked for a better person to help me through the process. I got his Apex two-piece design, polished with a black ghost brushed center."

These wheels aren't for his winning car though-they're destined for the '65 Corvette Coupe he's restoring now.

"I'm grateful to everyone who voted for me online and in person at Carlisle," Terry said. "I can't wait to get back to Corvettes at Carlisle, show my car, hang out with fellow Corvette enthusiasts, and continue celebrating the hobby I've loved for decades."
