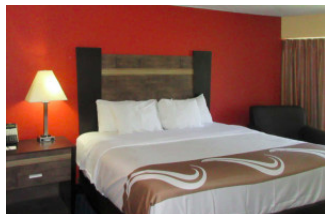

Camping at an Event

Camping during events is permitted in the Clay Street Parking Lot (except as noted on the map). During Import & Performance and GM Nationals, camping is located on the Carlisle Fairgrounds. (No camping at Truck Nationals.) Reservations may be made in advance by registered showfield participants and vendors. Others must visit the Registration Building outside Gate 3 during an event. Two bathhouses are available on the Carlisle Fairgrounds.

Take a little time to plan and prepare for your visit so you have the best experience possible. Read through our General Information, Flea Market Tips and Glossary to be fully prepared. If you need mobility assistance, call Scootaround at 888-441-7575 to rent a scooter.

Do:

- Wear comfortable shoes
- Bring sunscreen and other sun protection (hat, sunglasses, etc.)
- Prepare for changes in the weather by layering your clothing and bring rain protection (jacket, umbrella)
- Coolers are permitted, but no glass containers
- Electric convenience vehicles/scooters are permitted for mobility assistance. Single person scooters are available to rent outside Gate 3.
- Gas grills are permitted in camping areas
- Bring a cart or wagon to transport items you purchase in the flea market

Don't:

- No glass containers/bottles
- No drones
- No weapons/firearms
- No fireworks/flares
- No unauthorized golf carts, bicycles, skateboards, etc.
- No illegal substances
- Smoking is prohibited in certain areas
- Bringing your pets is discouraged
- No campfires



Spectator Rules

Events held at the Carlisle PA Fairgrounds

Updated January 2025. This document supersedes all previous versions.

REFUNDS

- No refunds are issued within 45 days of the event.
- Events take place rain or shine.

TICKETS

- Lost or stolen Season Passes will not be reissued.
- Re-admission is allowed on the same day with a hand stamp and punched ticket from the day's entry.

RESPECT THE VENUE

- Follow all posted rules and guidelines provided by Carlisle Events.
- Stay within designated spectator areas and respect any restricted zones.
- Use designated trash bins for disposal of waste.
- Open fire pits and fires are prohibited.
- Drones are not authorized on or near the facility.

SPECTATOR CONDUCT

- All participants must conduct themselves appropriately, respecting the inclusive and diverse community.
- Discrimination, harassment, bullying, xenophobia, racism, or any form of harassment is not tolerated.
- Zero tolerance policy on disruptive behavior. Offenders will be removed from the event.
- Keep noise levels reasonable. No offensive music.
- Respect personal space of fellow spectators.
- Avoid disruptive behavior that may impact others' enjoyment of the event.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

- No drunkenness, public nudity, burnouts, recklessness, foul language, offensive clothing, or disruptive actions.
- Security and event staff are authorized to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment.
- Management reserves the right to eject a participant for inappropriate conduct.

DRIVING ON-GROUNDS

- Vehicles must remain parked from arrival to departure.
- No cruising, burnouts, or use of unauthorized vehicles (side-by-sides, ATV's, scooters, dirt bikes, etc.)
- Personal mobility scooters are permitted.
- Golf carts must be preregistered – call Customer Service at 717-243-7855 for more information.

SEATING AND STANDING

- Use designated seating areas – grandstand, benches, food court – to avoid blocking walkways.
- Do not stand on seats or any structures that are not intended for standing.

CHILDREN AND PETS

- Always keep children under supervision.
- Service animals are permitted.
- **Please do not bring your pet.** Pavement gets very hot.
- We do permit pets, however, under the following guidelines:
 - Pets must have current vaccines and license.
 - Must be leashed and under your control at all times.
 - You must dispose of their waste.
 - No pets in the Food Court or any building.
 - You are fully responsible for your pet - any offensive or unsafe actions will result in expulsion without refund.

SAFETY AND LIABILITY

- Spectator parking is at your own risk.
- Carlisle Events does not guarantee the safety of property left on-site or off-site.
- Obey all local laws and regulations while attending the event.
- Report any concerns or issues to event staff or security personnel.

NO SMOKING AREAS

- Respect designated no-smoking areas.
- Dispose of cigarette butts in designated containers.
- No smoking in any buildings, Food Court, seating areas, or concession stands.

FIREARMS

- If you possess a valid firearm permit issued by the state of PA you are permitted to carry a concealed firearm on our property. However, we strongly encourage you to reconsider and refrain from doing so while attending our events or visiting our facilities. The open carry of firearms is strictly prohibited on our property regardless of any valid permits.

FIRST AID/EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- First Aid is located next to Guest Services, or you can call Security at 717-960-6429.
- Report injuries or emergencies promptly.
- Security is located inside Gate 3.
- Follow instructions from event staff and emergency personnel.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING

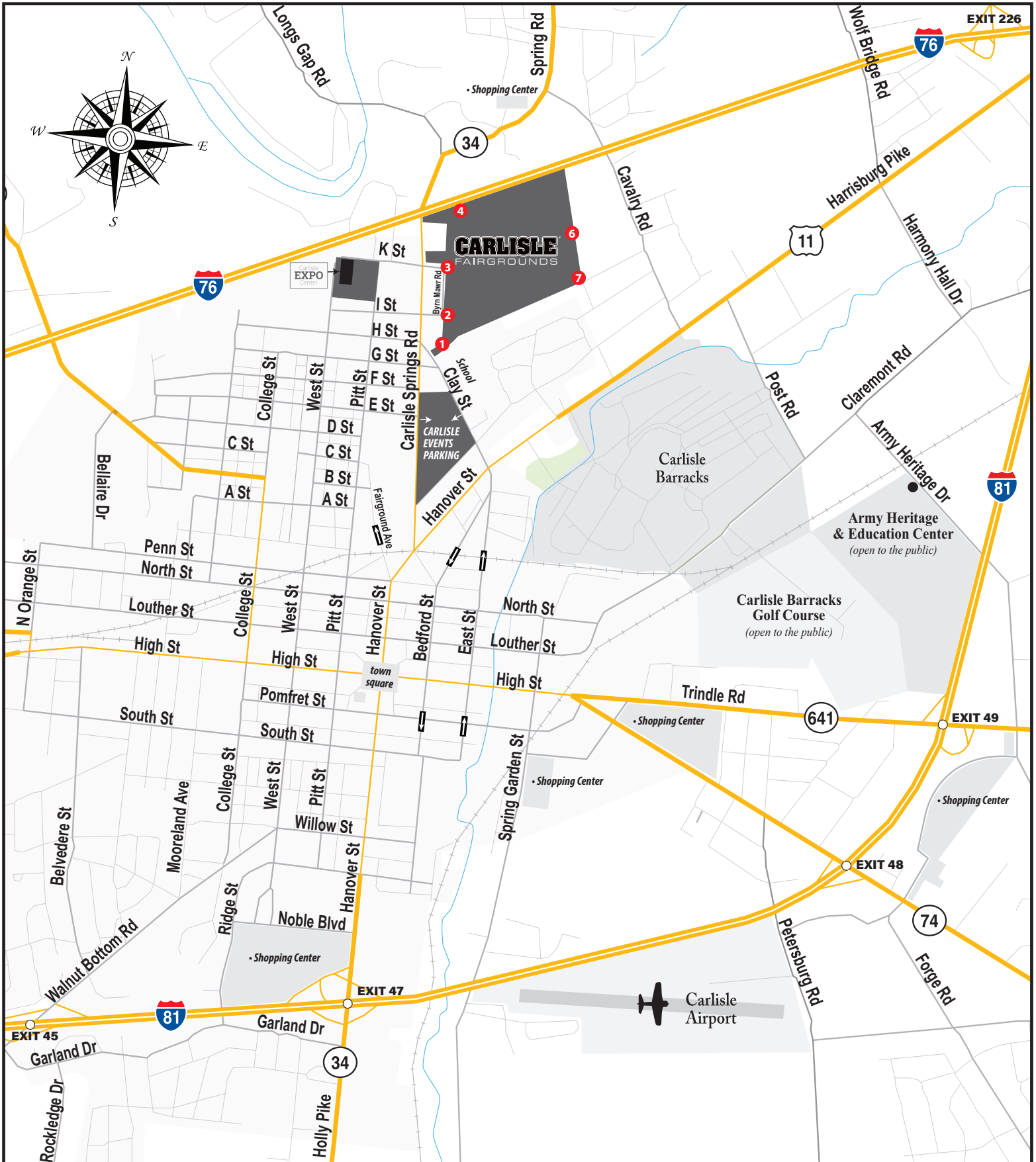
- Follow any event policies regarding photography and recording.

LIABILITY WAIVER

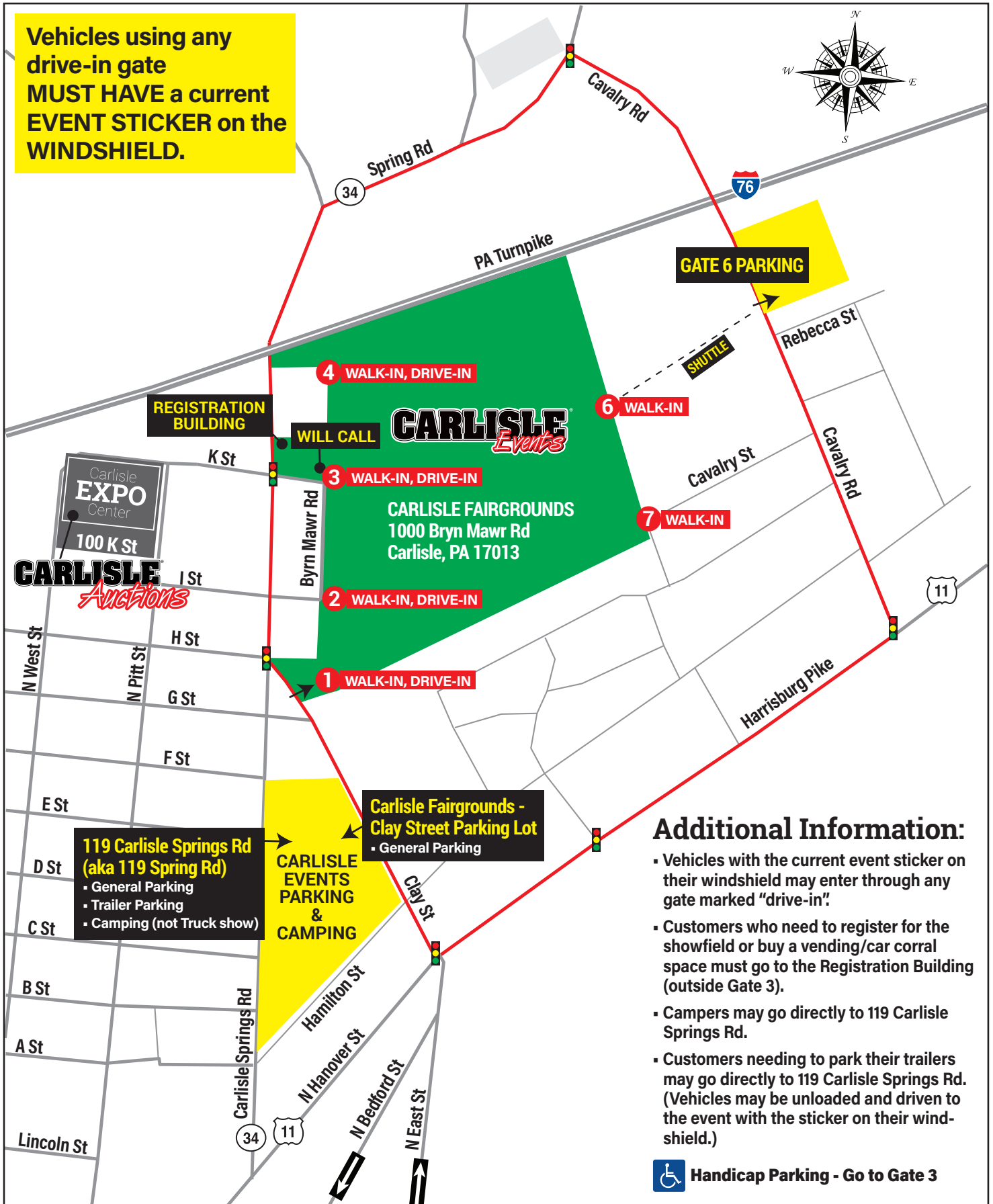
- Participants acknowledge the risks associated with the event and release organizers from liability.

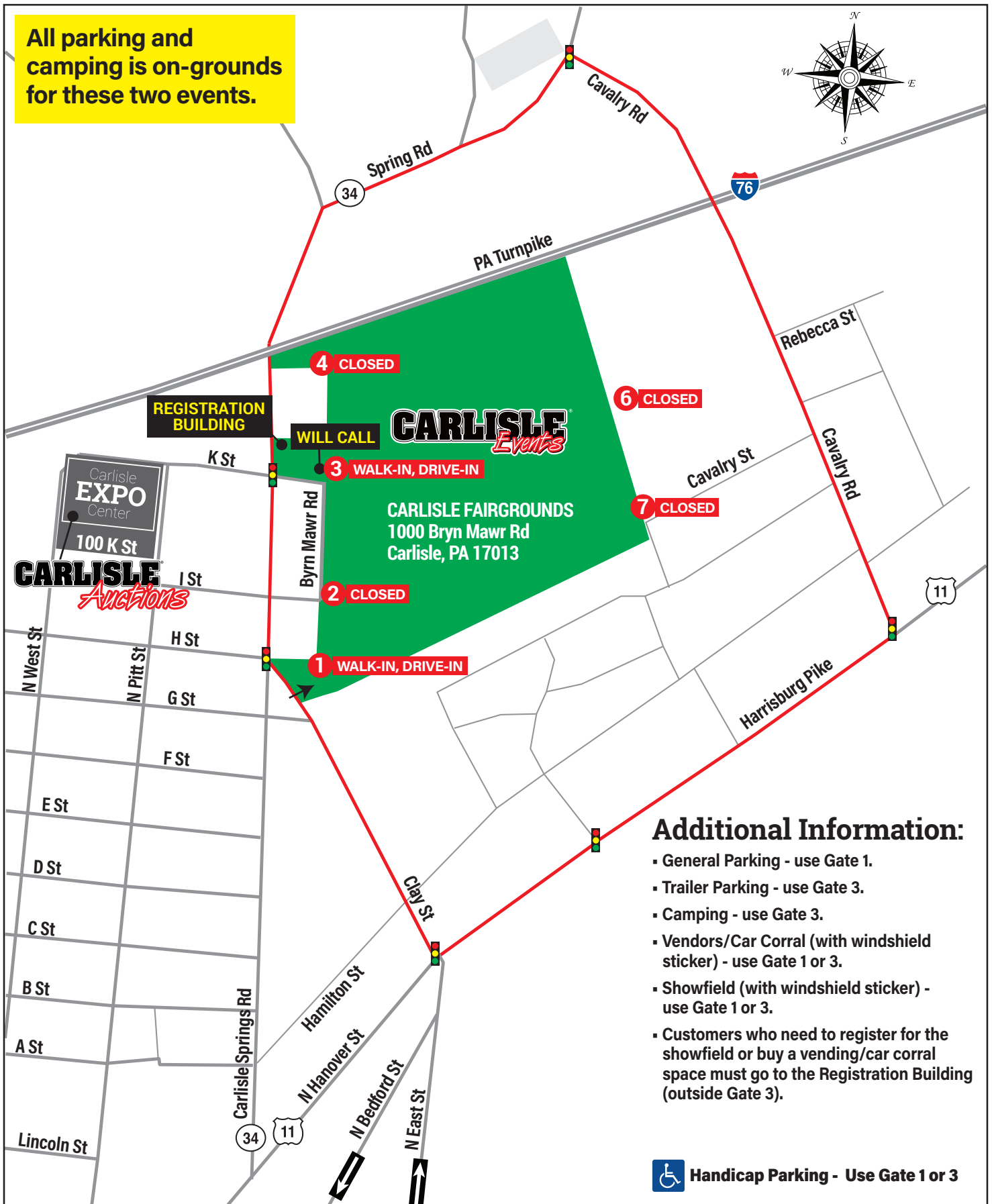
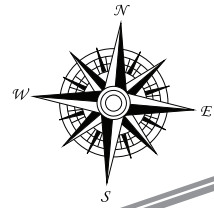


Parking & Camping Map: SPRING, FORD, CHRYSLER, TRUCK, CORVETTE, FALL

Additional Information:

- General Parking - use Gate 1.
- Trailer Parking - use Gate 3.
- Camping - use Gate 3.
- Vendors/Car Corral (with windshield sticker) - use Gate 1 or 3.
- Showfield (with windshield sticker) - use Gate 1 or 3.
- Customers who need to register for the showfield or buy a vending/car corral space must go to the Registration Building (outside Gate 3).

If additional parking space is needed please make sure you have a vendor space sticker on your vehicle and you can park for free in a Carlisle Events Parking Lot (see map), contact the Carlisle Events Security personnel for assistance.
ADMISSION	Pay the daily fee for an admission ticket or get an event pass.	A Showfield vehicle sticker provides daily admission each day of the event for the driver and one passenger. Additional passengers pay the daily admission fee.	A Vendor vehicle sticker provides daily admission each day of the event for the driver and one passenger. Vendors may request Event Passes for walk-in entry (at Will Call outside Gate 3) when leaving their vehicle on-grounds overnight.
CAMPING no hookups	May only register during an event, pre-registration not available.	Register in advance or at the Registration Building. No camping on the Showfield.	Only Flea Market Vendors (not Car Corral Vendors) may camp in their vending space(s) at no additional fee. If the camper/tent does not fit in the vending space, camping is available for a fee at 119 Carlisle Springs Road. Payment is accepted at the camping lot or may be purchased at the Registration Building.
